

#BETTERTRANSPORT

OUR PLEDGE

- Separation between motor traffic and people walking and travelling by bike should be achieved as completely as possible, following LTN 1/20 guidance
- We would establish an integrated public transport network, this includes park and ride sites in Worcester
- We support moving HGV parking from Croft Road car park
